Page 13, strike lines 17 through 18 and insert the following:

1                   (ii) by striking the period and insert-  
2                   ing a semicolon; and

Page 13, line 20, strike “paragraph” and insert “paragraphs”.

Page 13, line 24, strike the period and insert “; and”.

Page 14, beginning line 1, insert the following:

3                   “(9) facilitate interagency partnership opportu-  
4                   nities to support the innovation, entrepreneurial,  
5                   educational, and research capacity of geographic re-  
6                   gions with strength in quantum-related fields and in-  
7                   dustries to address, in partnership with industry,  
8                   universities, small businesses, and strategic allies  
9                   and partners, regional, national, societal, or  
10                  geostrategic challenges.”.

Page 40, strike lines 8 through 9 and insert the following:

1 (v) in subparagraph (E), by striking  
2 the period and inserting a semicolon;

Page 40, line 11, strike “subparagraph” and insert  
“subparagraphs”.

Page 40, line 16, strike the period and insert “;  
and”.

Page 40, beginning line 17, insert the following:

3 “(G) supporting, in collaboration with the  
4 Secretary of Commerce and Secretary of En-  
5 ergy, regional innovation initiatives in quantum  
6 information science, engineering, and tech-  
7 nology, and the adoption of viable quantum ca-  
8 pabilities, which may include the activities car-  
9 ried out pursuant to an award of funds under  
10 section 10388 of the Research and Develop-  
11 ment, Competition, and Innovation Act (Public  
12 Law 117–167; 42 U.S.C. 19108).”.

Page 70, line 20, strike the first “and”.

Page 70, line 22, strike “paragraph” and insert  
“paragraphs”.

Page 71, line 2, strike the period and insert “; and”.

Page 71, line 2, strike “and” after the semicolon.

Page 71, beginning line 3, insert the following:

1           “(9) support, in collaboration with the Sec-  
2           retary of Commerce and Director of the National  
3           Science Foundation, regional innovation initiatives  
4           in quantum information science, engineering, and  
5           technology, including quantum industry and non-  
6           profit entities and small and medium-sized busi-  
7           nesses and startups.”.
