

**AMENDMENT TO COMMITTEE PRINT OF H.R. 4091**

Page 3, after line 16, insert the following (and make such conforming changes as may be necessary):

1           “(B) projects supported by ARPA–E dur-  
2           ing the previous fiscal year that examine topics  
3           and technologies closely related to other activi-  
4           ties funded by the Department, and includes an  
5           analysis of whether in supporting such projects,  
6           the Director is in compliance with subsection  
7           (i)(1)(A); and”.

Page 4, after line 2, insert the following (and make such conforming changes as may be necessary):

8           (e) COORDINATION AND NONDUPLICATION.—Section  
9           5012(i)(1) of the America COMPETES Act (42 U.S.C.  
10           16538(i)(1)) is amended to read as follows:

11           “(1) IN GENERAL.—To the maximum extent  
12           practicable, the Director shall ensure that—

13           “(A) the activities of ARPA–E are coordi-  
14           nated with, and do not duplicate the efforts of,

1 programs and laboratories within the Depart-  
2 ment and other relevant research agencies; and  
3 “(B) ARPA–E does not provide funding  
4 for a project unless the prospective grantee  
5 demonstrates sufficient attempts to secure pri-  
6 vate financing or indicates that the project is  
7 not independently commercially viable.”.

Page 5, strike lines 4 through 9 and insert the fol-  
lowing:

8 “(B) \$497,000,000 for fiscal year 2021;  
9 “(C) \$567,000,000 for fiscal year 2022;  
10 “(D) \$651,000,000 for fiscal year 2023;  
11 and  
12 “(E) \$750,000,000 for fiscal year 2024.”.
