

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 8748**  
**OFFERED BY MR. RILEY OF NEW YORK**

Add at the end the following:

**1 SEC. 10. TRANSIT WORKFORCE STRATEGY AND REPORT.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than four years after  
3 the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of  
4 Transportation, acting through the Administrator of the  
5 Federal Transit Administration, shall submit to the Com-  
6 mittee on Transportation and Infrastructure and the  
7 Committee on Science, Space, and Technology of the  
8 House of Representatives and the Committee on Banking,  
9 Housing, and Urban Affairs and the Committee on Com-  
10 merce, Science, and Transportation a report that includes  
11 the following:

12 (1) An assessment informed by transportation  
13 stakeholder feedback on challenges and opportunities  
14 related to the transit workforce.

15 (2) A review and inventory of any activity of  
16 the Department of Transportation related to sup-  
17 porting the transit workforce.

18 (3) A strategy on how relevant operating ad-  
19 ministrations of the Department of Transportation

1 support the transit workforce, including by carrying  
2 out any of the following:

3 (A) Leveraging programs established pur-  
4 suant to sections 5505 and 5507 of title 49,  
5 United States Code to support the transit work-  
6 force.

7 (B) Supporting partnerships, including any  
8 such partnerships in rural communities, that  
9 enable transit workers to pursue or attain skills  
10 relevant to advanced transit technologies, in-  
11 cluding with respect to electric propulsion sys-  
12 tems, vehicle electrification, predictive mainte-  
13 nance, and cybersecurity.

14 (C) Any other activity as determined ap-  
15 propriate by the Administrator.

16 (4) Any recommendation informed by transpor-  
17 tation stakeholder feedback to promote the transit  
18 workforce through programs of the Department of  
19 Transportation.

20 (b) FISCAL YEAR UPDATE.—Subsection (d) of sec-  
21 tion 5507 of title 49, United States Code, is amendment  
22 by striking “2022 through 2026” and inserting “2027  
23 through 2031”.
