

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 2225
OFFERED BY MR. LAMB**

Page 133, after line 10, insert the following (and re-designate subsequent subsections accordingly):

1 (i) ENTREPRENEURIAL FELLOWSHIPS.—

2 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Director shall award
3 fellowships to Ph.D.-trained scientists and engineers
4 to help develop leaders capable of maturing prom-
5 ising ideas and technologies from lab to market and
6 forge connections between academic research and
7 government, industry, and finance.

8 (2) APPLICATIONS.—An applicant for a fellow-
9 ship under this subsection shall submit to the Direc-
10 tor an application at such time, in such manner, and
11 containing such information as the Director may re-
12 quire. At a minimum, the Director shall require that
13 applicants

14 (A) have completed a doctoral degree in a
15 STEM field no more than 5 years prior to the
16 data of the application; and

17 (B) have included in the application a let-
18 ter of support from the intended host institu-

1 tion that describes how the fellow will be em-
2 bedded in that institution's research environ-
3 ment.

4 (3) OUTREACH.—The Director shall conduct
5 program outreach to recruit fellowship applicants—

6 (A) from diverse research institutions;

7 (B) from all regions of the country; and

8 (C) from groups historically underrep-
9 resented in STEM fields;

10 (4) The Director may enter into an agreement
11 with a third-party entity to administer the fellow-
12 ships, subject to the provisions of this subsection.

13 (5) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—

14 There is authorized to be appropriated to the Direc-
15 tor \$100,000,000 for fiscal years 2022 through
16 2026, to carry out the activities outlined in this sub-
17 section.
