Add at the end of title VI the following:

1	SEC. 6 IMPLEMENTATION OF RECOMMENDATIONS BY
2	THE NATIONAL WILDLAND FIRE MANAGE-
3	MENT AND MITIGATION COMMISSION.
4	(a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds the following:
5	(1) Wildland fires pose a significant threat to
6	public safety, property, and natural resources.
7	(2) The National Wildland Fire Management
8	and Mitigation Commission (in this section referred
9	to as the "Commission") has provided critical rec-
10	ommendations for enhancing wildland fire science,
11	data, and technology resources.
12	(3) The Administration, through the Science
13	Mission Directorate, has the capability to support
14	and enhance wildland fire management through its
15	advanced research and technological expertise.
16	(b) Incorporation of Recommendations.—The
17	Administrator, in accordance with the goal for NASA's
18	Earth science and applications program set forth in sec-
19	tion 60501 of title 51, United States Code, and relevant

recommendations of the most recent decadal survey on Earth science and applications from space, shall incorporate the recommendations of the Commission, to the ex-4 tent practicable, which may include continuing to carry 5 out the following: 6 (1) Enhancing the collection, analysis, and dis-7 semination of data related to wildland fires, includ-8 ing satellite and remote sensing data. 9 (2)Supporting research and development 10 projects aimed at improving wildland fire prediction, 11 prevention, response, and recovery. 12 (3) Developing and deploying technologies that 13 can assist in monitoring, detecting, and mitigating 14 wildland fires. 15 (4) Conducting studies on the impact of climate 16 change on wildland fire behavior, frequency, and in-17 tensity. 18 (c) Interagency Coordination.—The Adminis-19 trator shall continue to coordinate, as practicable, with 20 other Federal, State, local, and Tribal entities to integrate 21 the Commission's recommendations into broader wildland fire management efforts. Such coordination may include 23 the following:

1	(1) Facilitating the sharing of wildland fire-re-
2	lated data and research findings with relevant agen-
3	cies and stakeholders.
4	(2) Participating in joint initiatives and projects
5	aimed at enhancing wildland fire management capa-
6	bilities.
7	(d) EVALUATION.—The Administrator shall conduct
8	periodic evaluations of NASA's efforts to incorporate the
9	Commission's recommendations and make adjustments as
10	necessary to maximize the effectiveness of such rec-
11	ommendations to support wildland fire mitigation and
12	management efforts.
13	(e) Reporting.—Not later than one year after the
14	date of the enactment of this Act, the Administrator shall
15	submit to the appropriate committees of Congress a report
16	detailing the activities undertaken by NASA to implement
17	the Commission's recommendations, including the fol-
18	lowing:
19	(1) A summary of research and development
20	projects initiated or supported.
21	(2) An assessment of the impact of such activi-
22	ties on wildland fire management and mitigation ef-
23	forts.

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- 1 (3) Any challenges or obstacles encountered in
- 2 implementing such recommendations.
