NATIONAL SPACEPORT STRATEGY: SPACE LAUNCH 2 AND REENTRY INFRASTRUCTURE. 3 (a) NATIONAL SPACEPORT STRATEGY.— 4 (1) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 515 of title 51, 5 United States Code, is amended by adding at the 6 end the following new section: 7 "§ 51502. National spaceport strategy 8 "(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Transpor-9 tation, in collaboration with the Secretary of Defense, the Chief of Space Operations of the United States Space 10 11 Force, the Administrator of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration, the Secretary of Commerce, and 12 13 the Secretary of State, shall develop a comprehensive national spaceport strategy (in this section referred to as the 14 'strategy') to enhance, coordinate, and ensure the resil-15 iency of the space transportation infrastructure of the 16 17 United States.

18 "(b) WORKING GROUP.—The Secretary of Transpor19 tation and the heads of agencies specified in subsection
20 (a) may establish a working group to develop the strategy.

"(c) STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT.—In developing
 the strategy, the Secretary of Transportation shall engage
 with relevant stakeholders, including in State government,
 industry, and academia, as appropriate.

5 "(d) ELEMENTS OF A STRATEGY.—The strategy6 shall include the following:

7 "(1) An evaluation of the demand for space
8 transportation services, including the civil, national
9 security, and commercial space transportation needs
10 of the United States and international commercial
11 markets.

"(2) An identification of legislative, regulatory,
or other policy changes needed to enable a resilient,
interoperable network of spaceports in support of
national objectives.

"(3) An identification of the range of long-term
funding options and related considerations for space
transportation infrastructure development, and priorities for investment, where appropriate.

"(4) An assessment of international space
transportation capabilities and investments, including opportunities for international partnerships and
maintaining United States competitiveness.

24 "(5) Other relevant elements, as the Secretary

1	"(e) TRANSMITTAL.—Not later than six months after
2	the date of the enactment of this section, the Secretary

7 "(3) The Secretary of Transportation shall consult 8 with the Secretary of Defense, the Administrator of the 9 National Aeronautics and Space Administration, and the 10 heads of other appropriate Federal agencies with respect 11 to subparagraphs (A) and (F) of paragraph (1), as appro-12 priate."; and

13 (B) by adding at the end the following new14 subsection:

15 "(e) RESTRICTION ON CERTAIN FUNDING OF PRO16 GRAM.—Activities carried out under this section may not
17 be funded through user fees.".
