On behalf of the Sub-seasonal to Seasonal (S2S) Precipitation Coalition, I am writing to congratulate you on the recent approval of H.R. 6093, the Weather Act Reauthorization Act of 2023, by the House Committee on Science, Space and Technology.

We strongly support Section 501 of the legislation, which directs the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration to establish two pilot projects in the western and central U.S. to improve S2S precipitation forecasting. Lead time is critical for making water management decisions, and few of these decisions are made within the time period of a short-term weather forecast. Improving precipitation forecasting at longer lead times is essential for helping water agencies manage the extremes of droughts and floods, and for providing actionable information that agricultural and urban water users can employ for planning and risk management.
