

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4186**  
**OFFERED BY Ms. Lofgren**

Page 4, line 3, through page 7, line 4, amend section 101 to read as follows:

1 **SEC. 101. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

2 (a) FISCAL YEAR 2014.—

3 (1) IN GENERAL.—There are authorized to be  
 4 appropriated to the Foundation \$7,171,918,000 for  
 5 fiscal year 2014.

6 (2) SPECIFIC ALLOCATIONS.—Of the amount  
 7 authorized by paragraph (1)—

8 (A) \$5,808,918,000 shall be made avail-  
 9 able to carry out research and related activities,  
 10 including—

11 (i) \$721,270,000 for the Biological  
 12 Science Directorate;

13 (ii) \$894,000,000 for the Computer  
 14 and Information Science and Engineering  
 15 Directorate;

16 (iii) \$851,070,000 for the Engineering  
 17 Directorate;

18 (iv) \$1,303,030,000 for the Geo-  
 19 sciences Directorate;

1 (v) \$1,299,800,000 for the Mathe-  
2 matical and Physical Science Directorate;

3 (vi) \$256,850,000 for the Social, Be-  
4 havioral, and Economics Directorate;

5 (vii) \$481,590,000 for the Inter-  
6 national and Integrative Activities Direc-  
7 torate; and

8 (viii) \$1,300,000 for the United  
9 States Arctic Commission;

10 (B) \$846,500,00 shall be made available  
11 for education and human resources;

12 (C) \$200,000,000 shall be made available  
13 for major research equipment and facilities con-  
14 struction;

15 (D) \$298,000,000 shall be made available  
16 for agency operations and award management;

17 (E) \$4,300,000 shall be made available for  
18 the Office of the National Science Board; and

19 (F) \$14,200,000 shall be made available  
20 for the Office of the Inspector General.

21 (b) FISCAL YEAR 2015.—

22 (1) IN GENERAL.—There are authorized to be  
23 appropriated to the Foundation \$7,279,496,770 for  
24 fiscal year 2015.

1           (2) SPECIFIC ALLOCATIONS.—Of the amount  
2 authorized by paragraph (1)—

3           (A) \$5,900,496,770 shall be made avail-  
4 able to carry out research and related activities,  
5 including—

6           (i) \$732,641,000 for the Biological  
7 Science Directorate;

8           (ii) \$908,094,000 for the Computer  
9 and Information Science and Engineering  
10 Directorate;

11           (iii) \$864,487,000 for the Engineering  
12 Directorate;

13           (iv) \$1,323,573,000 for the Geo-  
14 sciences Directorate;

15           (v) \$1,320,292,000 for the Mathe-  
16 matical and Physical Science Directorate;

17           (vi) \$260,899,000 for the Social, Be-  
18 havioral, and Economics Directorate;

19           (vii) \$489,182,000 for the Inter-  
20 national and Integrative Activities Direc-  
21 torate; and

22           (viii) \$1,320,000 for the United  
23 States Arctic Commission;

24           (B) \$858,500,000 shall be made available  
25 for education and human resources;

1           (C) \$203,000,000 shall be made available  
2 for major research equipment and facilities con-  
3 struction;

4           (D) \$298,000,000 shall be made available  
5 for agency operations and award management;

6           (E) \$4,300,000 shall be made available for  
7 the Office of the National Science Board; and

8           (F) \$15,200,000 shall be made available  
9 for the Office of Inspector General.
